Section 5 - Dress Code

Students attending Collegiate Academy work toward excellence and high standards of performance. These inward goals should be reflected outwardly through students' neat and clean manner.

Elementary Dress Code (PK-6)

Uniforms

Remote learners must abide by, at a minimum, the middle school dress code...

Students in grades K-6 wear uniforms, which are available at all major department stores. CAC has a "gently used" uniform store with tops and bottoms available at a nominal price. The CAC uniform store also takes uniform donations.

- Tops Any solid color polo, turtleneck, button up shirt, or sweater is permitted. All Collegiate Academy Spirit Wear are acceptable on Fridays.
- Bottoms Any khakis or solid color pants, shorts, skorts, capris, skirts or jumpers (including corduroy and cargo pants) may be worn, but may be no shorter than the bottom of the fingertips with your arms straight at the sides. Solid color opaque leggings that are not excessively tight are acceptable; tights may not be worn as a solitary garment. No sweatpants, or denim or lace can be worn, including Collegiate Academy sweatpants.
- Plaid The burgundy plaid and green plaid uniform items in the French Toast catalog may also be worn.
- Ties and cross ties May be worn appropriately.
- Long-sleeved shirts Solid colored long sleeved shirts may be worn under short-sleeved uniform shirts.
- Outerwear Solid color zip up hoodies/fleeces are permitted indoors with a uniform shirt worn underneath.

Elementary School Additional Dress Guidelines — (listed head to toe, general items at bottom)

- Hats May not be worn in the building.
- Hair Must be clean and conservatively styled. Eyes must be visible at all times. No words, numbers, letters or
 patterns may be designed into the hair.
- Make-up Is not allowed.
- Piercings Conservative earrings may be worn in ears only.
- Necklaces One necklace may be worn at a time, but must be worn inside the shirt.
- Shoes Should be closed-toe, closed-heel. Flats only. Sneakers or tennis shoes are acceptable. Appropriate athletic shoes must be worn in P.E. No Heelys may be worn.
- Clothing condition Clothing should appear neat, clean and in good condition.
- Clothing fit Clothing should fit. No baggy, excessively tight fitting, revealing, low-riding or suggestive attire is permitted. Shorts, dresses, skirts, skorts, or overalls, may be no shorter than fingertips when arms are at your sides.
- Clothing with a waistband Should be worn at the waist, no sagging pants.
- Scout uniforms May be worn on Scout days.
- School team uniforms May be worn on special days and game days.
- Tattoos No visible tattoos are allowed.
- Recess/Outdoors Sweatshirts or other winter apparel may be worn over uniforms at recess and when outdoors.
